## VERBAL NOTE

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic presents its compliments to Diplomatic and Consular Missions, International Organizations and Regional Offices of International Organizations accredited to the Hellenic Republic and would like to bring to the attention of the Esteemed Missions that the second booster dose (fourth in sequence) against COVID-19 has become available to all Greek citizens, permanent residents and members of the Diplomatic Corps, as follows: from April 7th for those above 80 years old, from April 13th for people above 70 and from April 15th for those above 60. Younger age groups are expected to be included in the vaccination program very soon.

According to the National Committee of Vaccinations, the administration of the second booster dose is encouraged after a period of at least four months following the administration of the first booster and the vaccines administered are Pfizer or Moderna. The vaccination appointment may be set by using the temporary social security number (PAMKA), through a visit to the Citizen Service Centers (K.E.P.) or to a pharmacy (please refer to webpage emvolio.gov.gr/pamka).

The Crisis Management Unit of this Ministry remains at your disposal in case of any queries or additional information and will keep Missions updated as the vaccination process unrolls to include younger age groups.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Diplomatic and Consular Missions, International Organizations and Regional Offices of International Organizations accredited to the Hellenic Republic the assurances of its highest consideration.
